The purpose of the Welding Inspector is to ensure that the weldment is capable of providing the required properties for its intended application. Wherever third party inspection is involved and fabrication is critical, it is necessary to inspect the fabrication by a Welding Inspector, who shall be technically capable to check the quality of weld.

# OBJECTIVES OF WELDING INSPECTOR COURSE



The Welding Education has been one of the important objective of IIW-India since its inception. Welding Inspector Course is designed to equip welding Personnel with quality aspects of fabrication.
